
Here is a close look at the points of the feedback I received:

Construindo o Formula - Universal Code Editor


Na última semana eu lancei uma novo aplicativo: [Formula – Universal Code Editor](#). E diferente de todos os aplicativos que eu fiz até agora, este foi complexo e não foi fácil desenvolver ele. Então pensando em todo o processo de construir ele eu decidi fazer uma série de posts no blog chamada de "Building it" para falar do processo de criar um aplicativo. E hoje falei sobre como escolhi o nome dele.

Bom, na verdade eu não cheguei a escolher o nome. Quando trabalho em um novo projeto eu uso codinomes, para este projeto em específico escolhi o nome Quebec. Como isso funciona? Simples, para projetos simples e que são algum tipo de ferramenta uso nomes de cidades na França (Como o projeto Nice, aka [Random 42](#), ou o projeto Lyon, aka [Time Calculator](#)), para projetos de diversão e entretenimento eu uso cidades dos Estados Unidos (como Las Vegas, aka o velho [#TrueOrDare](#)). E agora projeto Quebec (Canada) para ferramentas complexas.

Eu gosto de trabalhar com codinomes porque assim eu não fico preso no nome do produto, significando que eu posso mudar o nome facilmente, apenas alterando uma linha de código. Ou que eu não preciso esperar por um nome até que eu comece a fazer a codificar. O nome é a última coisa que eu faço ou me preocupo, e para escolher o nome Formula eu fui até a nação do Twitter!

Eu não sou bom em criar novos nomes. Eu iria lançar o aplicativo chamando ele de Quebec, mas eu sei que isso não é bom para o marketing nem para o produto. Então eu perguntei aos meus seguidores do Twitter, qual nome eu deveria utilizar. Eu recebi várias sugestões: Code X, IDE CODE, Code Master, Codz, Codez e muitos outros.

But the problem that I was dying to solve, was a design issue: especially the tile icons and the icon that was showed on the taskbar. Look at it, it's ugly. It has some blue borders, it is un? yeah? not good looking. Not good looking for a professional application ? and a paid one!



One of the firsts things I did was to make the tile transparent ? yeah! You can celebrate that! After the Dark mode support, this was the top 1 feedback I received about design. After solving this I tried some icon changes, and, well, it was not looking great too.



None of those was looking great (except maybe the second one). So, I tried a new approach, just remove the blue thing.




So, I tried to make it just a little bit bigger. Not too much.






